Submit this signed application, answers to the questions above, letter of recommendation, and work samples to Morris Museum of Art, c/o Michelle Schulte, 1 Tenth St., Augusta, GA 30901 by August 27.

Applications will be judged on clarity of answers and the letter of recommendation. **Not every applicant will be accepted into the program.** Accepted applicants will be notified by September 5, 2010. The first meeting of the year is on September 21, 2010.
