- Pre-registration is required.
- You must be 18 or older to participate in the adult workshop.
- Classes are offered on a first-come, first-served basis. Workshops must be paid in full to reserve your space.
- Refunds will be given up to seven business days before the workshop. After that time, all fees are nonrefundable.
- The Morris Museum of Art reserves the right to cancel a workshop due to insufficient enrollment. Participants already registered will be notified by phone and a full refund will be given.
- The museum reserves the right to change schedules, fees, workshop locations, art projects, and instructors as necessary.
- By registering for a workshop, you are automatically giving permission for you or your artwork to be photographed or video taped for advertising or publication purposes.

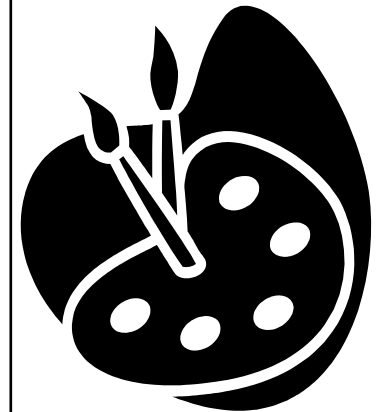
