Exhibition Symposium

Saturday, September 6, 10:00 a.m.–4:30 p.m.

This day-long symposium focuses on a diverse array of topics related to the lives of African Americans during the time of slavery. The program will begin with a special exhibition tour, followed by a series of lectures and performances on subjects such as the role of slavery in the city of Augusta, the history of spirituals, life at Redcliffe Plantation, and the quilt code myth that stems from tales of the Underground Railroad. Dr. Erskine Clarke, author and professor of American religious history emeritus at Columbia Theological Seminary, will deliver the keynote address, “The Landscape of the Georgia Lowcountry in Black and White: Overlapping and Competing Views and Memories.” For a complete schedule, visit www.themorris.org. **Members, \$20; nonmembers, \$35.** Cost includes museum admission, all lectures, and lunch.
